25 years of success for KRL Group



KRL Group, specialist suppliers in the document imaging market, is celebrating its 25th birthday. Since opening in Hull in 1985, KRL Group's growth has been rapid, and it now boasts annual sales in excess of £2 million, with over forty staff to provide a total solution for customers' document imaging requirements.

Business is booming across Lincolnshire's network of business and innovation centres, according to new figures. In only its second year, Think Tank in Lincoln is already at 50% occupancy.

Smart act for the Gelder Group

This latest security installation for Gelders provides a new CCTV system, designed and installed to BS 8418, with an innovative PC based access system integrated to control two new gates around a new site access road. Each gate can be controlled from the GB Security 24 hour remote control room, but also on site via a network based access control system.
